

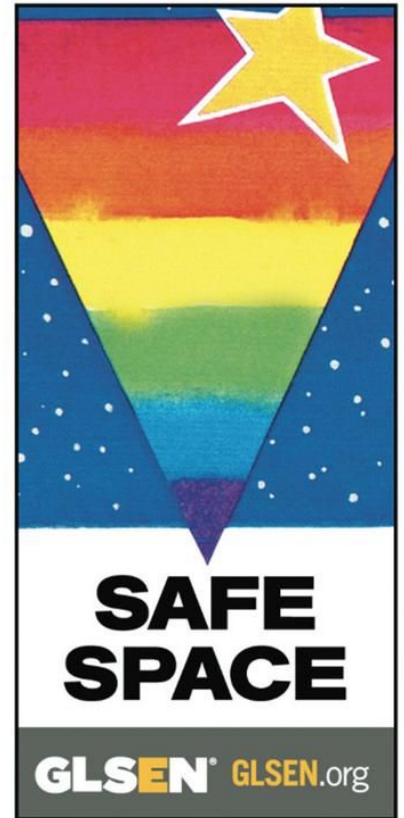


# Creating Inclusive Schools for LGBTQ Students

*Creating Inclusive Schools for LGBTQ Students* is a training designed for K-12 educators to explore how to create more inclusive environments for all students, regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression. Although designed for educators, any professional who works with youth can easily adapt this content to fit their practice needs.

During this 3-6 hour highly interactive workshop, participants will engage in activities that will increase their:

- Understanding of how to do allyship for LGBTQ youth
- Knowledge of LGBTQ student experiences at school
- Awareness of the prevalence of anti-LGBTQ language and behaviors in school environments
- Skills to successfully intervene and address instances of anti-LGBTQ bullying
- Ability to advocate for the rights of LGBTQ youth
- Awareness of resources and supports for educators and students



**Participants will receive a certificate of attendance for their CEU/PD hours.**
